

CLONOSEQ MRD TESTING IN BLOOD

Blood collections now available to clonoSEQ patients at home or through LabCorp® Patient Service Centers nationwide

Want to schedule a blood draw to enable clonoSEQ MRD testing?

Having trouble finding a place where you can obtain a blood draw safely due to COVID-19?

Adaptive Biotechnologies, the company that provides clonoSEQ testing, now offers two convenient ways for patients to safely obtain blood draws outside a hospital or clinic setting for use in clonoSEQ testing:

- Adaptive has collaborated with LabCorp to provide access to minimal-contact blood collection services* for clonoSEQ patients at any of LabCorp's nearly 2,000 Patient Service Centers nationwide.
- Adaptive has collaborated with Phlebotek to provide access to mobile phlebotomy services which allow clonoSEQ patients to have a blood draw performed by a qualified professional in the comfort of their own homes.

To use these services, your healthcare provider can simply contact Adaptive when ordering your clonoSEQ test and let us know that you would like your blood to be drawn at a LabCorp facility or at your home.

For a blood draw at a LabCorp facility, all you need to do is make an appointment! A clonoSEQ Clinical Services representative will contact you to help with this process.

Enter your zip code and select **"Routine labwork"** as the reason for your visit.



You can then select your preferred LabCorp location and click **"Make an Appointment"** to set up a convenient time.

When you arrive at LabCorp, your clonoSEQ blood draw order will already be in the LabCorp system.

For a home-based blood draw, the phlebotomist who will perform your blood draw will contact you to set up an appointment! This phlebotomist has passed a rigorous certification process and is required to submit to daily COVID-19 monitoring checks. All phlebotomists are required to wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) throughout the duration of the home visit.

Once your blood draw is complete, Adaptive and our collaborators will take it from there! Your healthcare provider will receive the results of your clonoSEQ testing and communicate those results to you as they would normally.

clonoSEQ® is available as an FDA-cleared *in vitro* diagnostic (IVD) test service provided by Adaptive Biotechnologies to detect minimal residual disease (MRD) in bone marrow samples from patients with B-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia (ALL) or multiple myeloma. clonoSEQ is also available for use in other lymphoid cancers and sample types as a CLIA-regulated laboratory developed test (LDT) service.
